EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rohner Center's Annual Report encompasses 32 books, articles, and chapters either published or in press, and 31 articles in preparation or submitted for publication (by Faculty Affiliates, Student Affiliates, and Participating Members and their students). We received more than 700 requests for measures and books in many languages. Affiliates received 10 honors/awards. They presented 13 invited papers and participated in (virtual) symposia. A total of 48 research projects on topics concerning interpersonal acceptance-rejection were initiated or completed during the academic year. Rohner was invited to be a manuscript reviewer for 31 publications. Rohner and other affiliates and participating members in the Rohner Center were involved in many "Professional Service" activities such as serving on editorial boards and serving as peer reviewers for journals and book publishers.

C. National and International Applications of Rohner's Interpersonal Acceptance-Rejection Theory (IPARTheory) and Associated Measures

- Use of Rohner's IPARTheory and associated measures for assessment, intervention, treatment, and evaluation (including custody evaluation) of children and parents involved in parental alienation and estrangement. Countries involved: Bangladesh, Canada, Ireland, Italy, Macedonia, Poland, Romania, Slovenia, Turkey, U.S.A., and others. In conjunction with this work, Rohner also serves as an Advisory Board Member for educational programs for the judiciary and families in four counties in Texas. The program is "Resetting the Family: An Educational Program for Parents and Children in Conflict".
- 2. In response to an invitation by the APA, the Rohner Center provided diagnostic measures in Ukrainian to be used by psychologists, psychiatrists, and others who work with psychologically traumatized children and adults in the Ukraine. The Rohner Center has 35 measures in up to 75 languages worldwide. All of them are used internationally to help assess the effects and other correlates of perceived interpersonal rejection and acceptance. Interpersonal rejection is known to be associated panculturally with problems of anxiety, depression, suicide ideation and attempts, substance use, and many other emotional and behavioral problems. Luba Roshko, M.D. (from Ukraine) has graciously volunteered to translate many of these measures into Ukrainian, which we are now making available gratis to Ukrainian professionals.

Handbook. There are now over 1,700 known users of **Rohner** & **Khaleque's** *Handbook for the Study of Parental Acceptance and Rejection.* Instruments by Rohner published therein are used especially often in basic and applied research, but also in clinical practice, court proceedings regarding parental alienation, child custody, divorce proceedings, foster and adoption placement, and in parenting education programs (often in the context of pre-test and post-test evaluations) and other contexts. The Handbook is also one of the most frequently requested texts from the UConn Interlibrary Loan Department. The *Handbook* is now translated or is being translated into multiple languages.

Rohner's *The Warmth Dimension* is translated into Greek, Korean, and Persian languages. It is now (2024), being translated into Bulgarian.

Dissertations and Theses. Over 350 doctoral dissertations and Master's theses in the U.S. and internationally are known to have been completed using research instruments (especially the Parental Acceptance-Rejection Questionnaire, the Personality Assessment Questionnaire, the Physical Punishment Questionnaire, and more recently the Intimate Adult Relationship Questionnaire) created by **Rohner**. Many other theses and dissertations are in preparation internationally.

Publications. More than 1,000 books, chapters, and articles are known to have been published using research instruments created by **Rohner**. Many others are in preparation, and new ones are regularly discovered.
