EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Rohner Center's Annual Report encompasses 43 books, articles, and chapters either published or in press, and 13 articles in preparation or submitted for publication (by Faculty Affiliates, Student Affiliates, and Participating Members and their students). We received more than 700 requests for measures and books in many languages. Affiliates presented 35 invited papers and participated in (virtual) symposia. A total of 14 research projects on topics concerning interpersonal acceptance-rejection were initiated or completed during the academic year. Rohner was invited to be a manuscript reviewer for 32 publications. Rohner and other affiliates and participating members in the Rohner Center were involved in many "Professional Service" activities such as serving on editorial boards and serving as peer reviewers for journals and book publishers.
